POLICY STATEMENT – B2

Controlled Neighborhood Play (CNP) for Bowling

1. General:

- 1.1. This policy establishes the parameters by which non-residents of Sun City West (SCW) may utilize the Sports Pavilion's bowling facility.
- 1.2. Controlled Neighborhood Play (CNP) is defined as the participation of a resident of a local and bona fide senior community other than SCW designated by the General Manager.
- 1.3. Participation by a qualified CNP bowler may be as an individual in open bowling, a member of a league team composed primarily of SCW residents, or as a team in a league composed primarily of SCW residents, or as a league composed primarily of non-residents as defined above, participating in league play, tournament play and open bowling.

2. Authority: The General Manager shall be responsible for the implementation of this policy.

3. Policy: The Sports Pavilion Manager, under the direction of the General Manager, shall grant approval for CNP based on the availability of space and opportunity. Residents of SCW shall have priority over non-residents during open bowling, on any team or league composed primarily of SCW residents up until the league is formed according to the procedures established by the Sports Pavilion Manager and approved by the General Manager.

4. Fee:

- 4.1. Participants in CNP shall pay a fee established by the Governing Board to participate in league play effective 1 July, 2006. CNP bowlers will be issued a card to allow them to open bowl at a CNP rate established by the Governing Board.
- 4.2. All other non-residents permitted to use the bowling facility shall pay the "Guest" fee established by the Governing Board.
