**REVISION POLICY STATEMENT – B3**

**Bowling Lane Conditioning**

---

- 1.0 General: This policy establishes the process by which bowling lane conditioning is established and implemented.
- 1.1 Lane conditioning is a very broad term used to describe a combination of specific factors on a bowling lane. These factors include: type, lane preparation, conditioner type, conditioner pattern, usage, frequency of conditioner application and external factors. When these factors are altered, a bowler's ability to maintain their score is greatly affected. The objective of this policy is to establish and maintain superior playing conditions on the lanes.
- 1.2 This establishes a cooperative policy including bowlers and management to define and implement lane conditions that reflect enhanced bowler satisfaction.
- 2.0 Authority: The General Manager shall be responsible for the implementation of this policy.
- 3.0 Policy:
- 3.1 The Bowling Committee reviews and makes recommendations to the General Manager or designee regarding lane conditioning. Management shall respond in writing to all committee recommendations.
- 3.2 The Mechanical Operations Supervisor shall establish procedures for the routine maintenance requirements of the bowling lanes. Revisions to procedures shall be provided to the Bowling Committee and posted.
- 3.3 Requests for lane conditioning treatments or maintenance that provide preferential treatment will not be honored without approval of the Sports Pavilion Manager.
