POLICY STATEMENT – G5

Player Assistants, Enforcement of Pace of Play, and Local Rules for Golf

1.0 Purpose:

To establish and maintain Player Assistants, an acceptable pace of play, and to authorize the General Manager or his designee to establish and enforce local rules of play and conduct.

2.0 Policy:

It is the policy of the Recreation Centers of Sun City West, Inc., hereafter referred to as the Association, to require all players to maintain a pace of play that will ensure the absence of an open hole between players. The first players of the day shall maintain a pace of play not more than fifteen minutes per hole, and all players that follow should strive to do likewise.

- 2.1** Subject to any fiscal restraints imposed by the Governing Board, the General Manager or his designee shall provide Player Assistants for each course, to monitor and enforce the pace of play and all local rules for play and conduct. Player Assistants shall be Owner Members or Associate Members of the Association, in good standing.
- 2.2** Player Assistants shall encourage and assist players to maintain the proper pace of play. Should players fall behind, they are to be asked to increase the pace of play, until there is no open hole before them. If significant progress has not been made to reduce the distance to within one hole of the players immediately ahead, the slow players shall be required to cease play and move forward to within one hole of the players ahead. Should the players then be unable to maintain an acceptable pace of play, they shall be required to leave the course. In such an event, no refund of fees shall be permitted.
- 2.3** Players shall readily comply with all directives of a Player Assistant. In the event that players direct any verbal abuse toward a Player Assistant, or golf course staff, their identity shall be provided to the appropriate golf course manager, who shall forward a full report of the incident to the Golf Operations Manager, within forty-eight hours of the incident.
 - 2.3.1** Following a personal review of the incident, and a determination that the incident has been substantiated, the Golf Operations Manager may impose a penalty of not more than a thirty (30) day loss of playing privileges on all Association Golf Courses. In such an event, a full report of the incident, the review, and the penalty imposed shall be immediately forwarded to the General Manager, with a copy to the President of the Governing Board.
 - 2.3.2** The offending player(s) may appeal to the General Manager for a final determination, however, the General Manager may not impose a greater penalty. Further, in the event the offending player(s) is an Owner Member or Associate Member of the Association; the player(s) may appeal to the Governing Board in accordance with the Association's Bylaws.
- 2.4** The Association shall pursue the prosecution of any player who physically abuses or is the cause of any injury to Player Assistants or golf course staff.
